Select Dry Cycle/Options

- 1 Press the **Power** button.



- 2 Turn the knob to select the desired cycle.



- 3 Select modifiers, extra functions, and options.

* All buttons are touch type.

- If you change the cycle, the preset modifiers and options will be changed. Set them again.

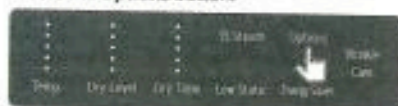


- 4 Press the **Start/Pause** button.



Using Options

- 1 Press the **Options** button.



- 2 Turn the knob to select the desired option. Press the **OK** button to save the option.

- Options lists may vary by model.



- 3 Turn the knob to select the desired setting and press the **OK** button to save the setting.



- 4 To return to the previous screen, press the **Options** button again or press the **Previous** button.

NOTE

- If no action is taken for several minutes after pressing the **Options** button, the display reverts to the previous screen.

Using Cycle List Edit Edit the list of dry cycles as desired.

- 1 Press the **Options** button.



- 2 Turn the knob to select **Cycle List Edit** and press the **OK** button.



- 3 Turn the knob to select the desired cycle and press the **OK** button to include or exclude cycles.

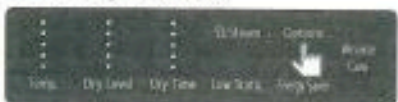
- If a cycle is added, a check mark is displayed by that cycle.
- The **Normal** cycle cannot be deleted.
- Change the order of the cycles in the list using **Additional Settings > Cycle Optimization** on the product or Product Cycle Management in the **LG ThinQ** application.



- 4 Press the **Previous** button to save the cycle list.
- 5 To return to the previous screen, press the **Options** button again or press the **Previous** button.

Using Cycle Optimization Organizes the cycle list and options automatically based on your usage patterns.

- 1 Press the **Options** button.



- 2 Turn the knob to select **Additional Settings** and press the **OK** button. Turn the knob to select **Cycle Optimization** and press the **OK** button.

- 3 Turn the knob to select **On** or **Off** and press the **OK** button.

- **On** is the default setting.
- Selecting **Off** retains the current list order.



- 4 To return to the previous screen, press the **Options** button again or press the **Previous** button.

Select Wash Cycle/Options

* All buttons are touch type.

- 1 Press the **Power** button.
 - On models with the **exDispense** function, a notice will appear if the detergent or softener is low. Refill the reservoirs as needed.



- 2 Turn the knob to select the desired cycle.



- 3 Select modifiers, extra functions, and options.
 - If you change the cycle, the preset modifiers and options will be changed. Set them again.

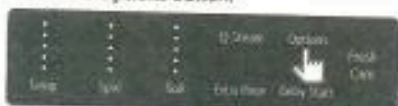


- 4 Press the **Start/Pause** button.

Cómo usar la edición de la lista de ciclos

- Si agrega un ciclo, se mostrará una marca de verificación junto al mismo.
- Los ciclos **Normal** y **Tub Clean (Limpieza de Tina)** no pueden eliminarse.
- Cambie el orden de los ciclos en la lista con **Additional Settings (Ajustes adicionales) > Cycle Optimization (Optimización del ciclo)** en el producto o en la administración de ciclos del producto en la aplicación **LG ThinQ**.



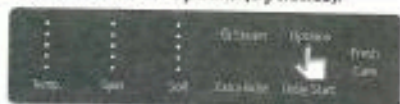
4 Presione el botón **Anterior** para guardar la lista de ciclos.

Using Cycle List Edit

Edit the list of wash cycles as desired.

- 3 Turn the knob to select the desired cycle and press the **OK** button to include or exclude cycles.
- If a cycle is added, a check mark is displayed

by that cycle.

- The **Normal** and **Tub Clean** cycles cannot be deleted.
- Change the order of the cycles in the list using **Additional Settings > Cycle Optimization** on the product or **Product Cycle Management** in the **LG ThinQ** application.

- 5 To return to the previous screen, press the **Options** button again or press the **Previous** button.
